

Present in planning?

social (requesting, wishing, language to support collaboration)
describing: incidents, objects or how something works

asking and answering questions about task
offering suggestions/solutions

re/telling a story in the style of the text

reciting from memory or reading aloud

explaining their views and thinking, answering 'why/how?' questions in detail using specialist vocabulary

describing a process or sequence using specialist vocabulary

performing a poem, narrative or song, controlling: tone, expression, volume, voice

present an argument, sequence points logically, use evidence and persuasive language

respond to the reasoning of another by developing or modifying their own argument

ask questions about a topic, in a sequence

summarise an argument and explain a conclusion

participate in group discussion

acting as spokesperson
